Guide for the use of Temporary Spare Tyres (T Type)

As the name implies, these tyres are only to be utilised for the shortest time and shortest journeys: their role is simply to allow travel to the nearest dealer in order to have the original tyre repaired or replaced.

In general, temporary spare tyres should only be used for a maximum of 24 hours and they are strictly limited in their speed as well as the distance of use.

The relatively high pressure of these tyre is critical for safety: always follow the pressure, speed and importantly tyre placement recommended by the vehicle manufacturer.

Use great caution when driving on a Temporary Spare as vehicle dynamics, steering response and braking performance are likely to be less predictable and unexpected.

Importantly, only ever fit a maximum of one Temporary Spare to your vehicle!

If you are in doubt, always feel free to refer to your local tyre expert.

This Bulletin should be considered as being of a general advisory nature only. In case of conflict with existing recommendations issued by a vehicle manufacturer, these latter recommendations should apply.
