### Replacing tyres on Four Wheel Drive (4WD) and All wheel drive (AWD) vehicles.

When tyre replacement is required on Four Wheel Drive (4WD) and All wheel drive (AWD) vehicles, ATIC recommends replacing all four tyres.

- This is critical in order to avoid damage to transmission components.
- The worn tyres will have smaller rolling circumferences than the new tyres and any difference in the rolling circumferences is likely to lead to expensive damage to the vehicle's drive train.
- Additionally, it is also important to ensure the spare tyre(s) carried are compatible with the four road tyres fitted for the same reason.

If you are in doubt, always feel free to refer to your local tyre expert.

This Bulletin should be considered as being of a general advisory nature only. In case of conflict with existing recommendations issued by a vehicle manufacturer, these latter recommendations should apply.
